



CPD Provider Ideas

Practising architects must take all reasonable steps to maintain competency in the practice of architecture (Section 16 of the *Architects Act 2002*). As a way of demonstrating this, the Board requires architects to undertake a minimum of 20 hours of CPD activities each year, and to report annually on CPD undertaken as part registration renewal. Queensland's CPD reporting year is from 1 April to 31 March.
